USF Health Taneja College of Pharmacy Timeline

The Taneja College of Pharmacy (TCOP) was established by the Florida Board of Governors in 2009 and became Florida's first public, comprehensive college of pharmacy in a metropolitan area.

2011

Graduate Programs was founded in 2013 with the mission to create graduate level education programs in pharmacy while producing global pharmacy leaders, one scholar at a time.

2015

In 2015, Pharmacy Plus opened for business on the first floor of the USF Health Morsani Center for Advanced Healthcare.

2016

In 2019, the University of South Florida received a \$10 million gift from Taneja Family Foundation to name the USF Health Taneja College of Pharmacy.

2024

2009

USF Health admitted the first class of PharmD students.

2013

TCOP earned its first full accreditation in 2015 from the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), marking a huge milestone for the young school and validating the innovative education experience offered to USF Health pharmacy students.

2015

TCOP was officially accepted as a chapter of the international Rho Chi Honor Society in 2016, and 43 of the college's students and faculty were inducted as the charter members.

2019

The PharmD program moves into the state-of-the-art USF Health Downtown Facility to expand interprofessional educational initiatives, technology, and creative learning development.
