#### **Position Summary**

Reporting to the Sr. Director of Development for the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS), this major gift fundraiser is responsible for establishing and managing prospect and donor relationships through identification, cultivation, solicitation and stewardship to meet fundraising goals in alignment with the mission and aspirations of the College of Arts and Sciences and the University of South Florida. The incumbent will play a key role in the overall growth of private philanthropy in support of the university.

#### Responsibilities

#### Fundraising

- Identify, cultivate, and solicit prospects to close major gifts of \$50,000+ for top funding priorities.
   Fundraising dollar, visit and proposal goals will be determined through conversations with leadership and based on the prospect pool and unit potential.
- Maintain a significant prospect portfolio and strategically manage relationships through face-toface and virtual visits to bring major solicitations to closure.
- Continuously update the prospect management database with information related to donor strategies, contacts and results.
- Ensure delivery of appropriate stewardship initiatives, partnering with the offices of Donor Relations, Foundation Scholarships and Donor Events as needed.
- Engage with and support volunteer leadership and advisory boards across CAS.

#### Collaboration

- Serve as an active member of the CAS Advancement Team, bringing creativity and innovation to the team's fundraising initiatives.
- Intentionally build and invest in developing strong relationships with the CAS leaders and faculty to promote a culture of philanthropy.
- Identify and facilitate opportunities for university leaders and colleagues to support the cultivation and solicitation of prospective donors.
- Develop strong relationships with Advancement leadership, staff and departments to leverage the tools and resources available to ensure prospects and donors have a meaningful experience with USF.
- Collaborate with gift officers in other units and on regional campuses, as appropriate.

#### **Professional Development**

- Constantly seek an up-to-date understanding of initiatives and programs (product knowledge) at the College of Arts and Sciences and the University of South Florida.
- Stay abreast of industry trends to integrate best practices into daily work.



The nation's fastest rising university, USF ranks 46th among public universities and 103rd among all public and private universities, according to *U.S. News & World Report*. Florida's only metropolitan Preeminent Research University, USF earned the top score for 2020 Performance-Based Funding, which measures categories such as affordable access and preparing students for success in high-demand career fields.

With campuses in Tampa, St. Petersburg and Sarasota-Manatee, USF's innovation and economic development efforts generate more than \$582 million in statewide impact each year, sustain more than 4,000 jobs and return more than \$71 million in tax revenue to local, state and federal coffers, according to a 2019 analysis from the Washington Economics Group, a leading national firm. Eighty-two percent of the jobs created by USF innovation statewide are in the knowledge-based services sector.

Magali Cornier Michael was recently appointed as acting dean for the USF College of Arts and Sciences (CAS). In addition to her role as acting dean, Michael has been at the University of

South Florida since 2018 and is a professor of English. Prior to her move to the Tampa campus, Michael served as dean for the College of Arts and Sciences at the USF St. Petersburg campus.

At the St. Petersburg campus, she was an active member of the multi-campus CAS senior leadership team, which has worked with faculty, advisors and staff to make significant strides forward in student and faculty success.

Michael earned her BA in English from the University of Georgia and her MA and PhD in English from Emory University. Prior to joining USF, she was a professor of English and associate dean of the McAnulty College and Graduate School of Liberal Arts at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh.

She has published three single-authored books and several articles and book chapters. On the teaching front, she has taught many courses at all levels, from freshman- to doctoral-level courses, especially in the areas of post-World War II literature, women's literature, literary theory and creative writing. In her work with doctoral students, she has directed 11 dissertations to completion and has one currently in progress.
